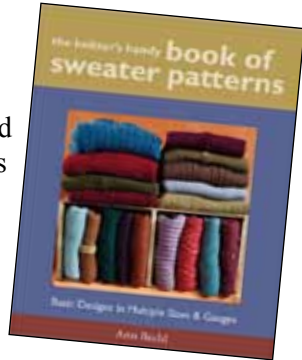
Ann Budd Classes
