1. Click on the red box that will show in the upper right/left hand corner (depends on your browser)
2. Scroll down to My Details
3. At User Profile screen, select Subscription History
4. In the far right column, alongside the Active status will be an Invoice No. This is linked through to a PDF. This receipt shows your Membership Number. (Put it in a safe place for next time!)
